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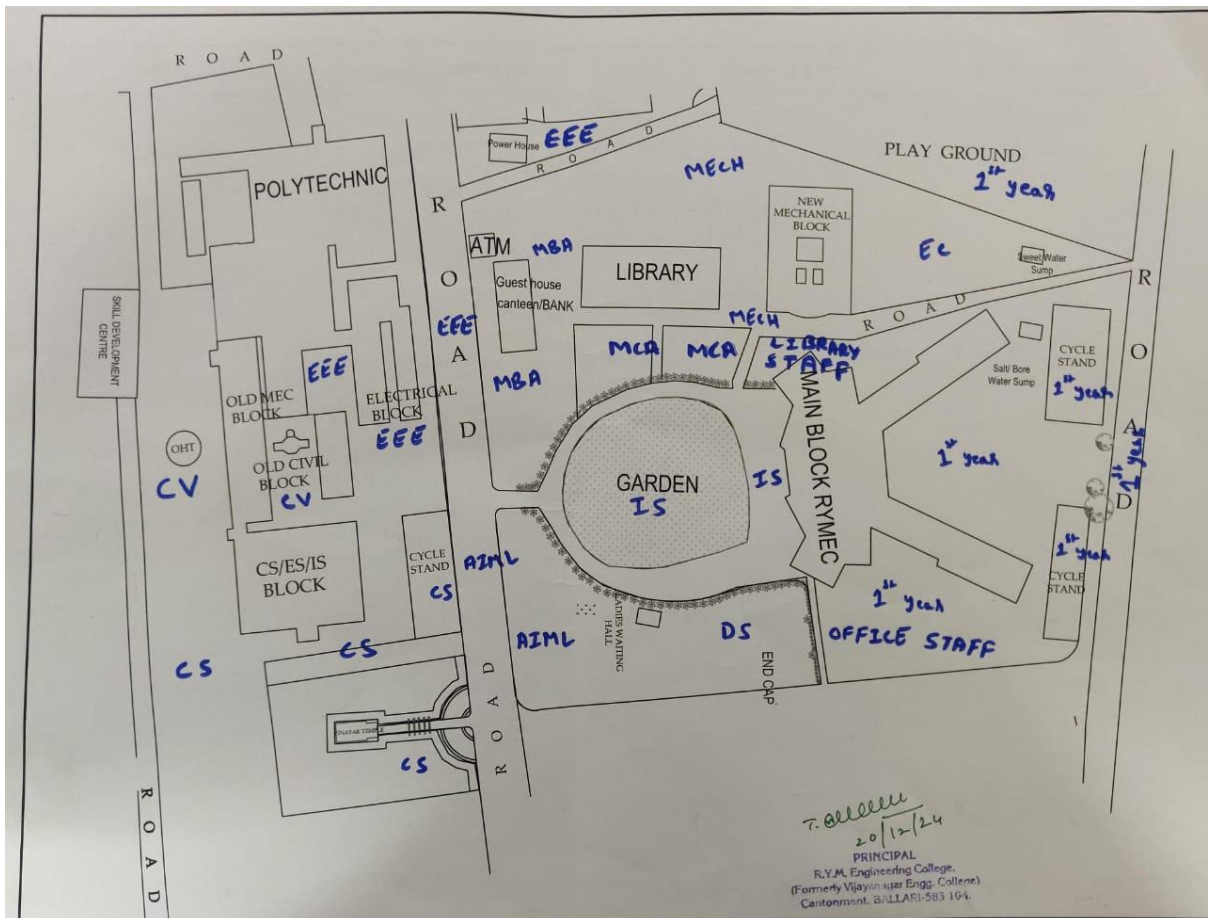




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Objectives

3. Implement effective waste management systems, including segregation and recycling.
4. Encourage participation in tree planting and other eco-friendly initiatives.

Activities Undertaken

Campus Cleanliness Drives

- **Frequency:** Weekly, with a special emphasis on 22nd December 2024.
- **Details:** Students, faculty, and staff actively participated in cleaning classrooms, laboratories, cafeterias, corridors, and outdoor areas. Special attention was given to high-traffic zones such as the library and common areas.

Waste Management Initiatives

Awareness Campaigns (future plan)
